**RESILIENT LOUISIANA COMMISSION CERTIFICATION PURSUANT TO ACT 302 OF THE 2020
REGULAR SESSION**

In accordance with R.S. 42:17.1 this notice shall serve as certification of the inability of the Resilient Louisiana Commission (“RLC”) to otherwise operate in accordance with the Louisiana Open Meetings Law due to such a meeting being detrimental to the health, safety, and/or welfare of RLC members and the public as a result of the public health emergency, as declared by Governor John Bel Edwards.
