

FRESHWATER & SALTWATER FISHING TOURNAMENT AND RODEOS

Phase II & III Suggestive Regulations for Safe Operations

Registration and briefing:

- Encourage online registration.
- Temperature will be checked upon entering registration site.
- Participants required to wear face covering in registration area.
- A protective shield will be at the site registration trailer as a barrier between staff and anglers.
- Staff will be wearing PPE.
- Tournament staff and volunteers will be wearing face coverings during tournament hours.
- Limit number of anglers allowed in the registration area. Staff will monitor at the door and keep participants 6' apart as letting them enter. In, register, and out.
- Remain in vehicle until space becomes available.
- For any signature required, have one time use and disposable pens.
- Briefings would be virtual and taped for online viewing, with a set and limited time live video Q and A session.

Weigh In:

- More flights so less anglers in a flight.
- Anglers wait in boats until your flight is called.
- Participants are required to remain at least 6' from others at all times while in weigh-in area.
- Staff will wear PPE and have temperature checked each day.
- Participant required to wear face protection and have temperature checked daily.
- Crowd always encouraged to practice social distancing.
- Need to have security or personnel responsible for controlling social distancing outside the restricted weigh area.
- Need bicycle racks or rope/stanchions to control restricted weigh in area.
- Need hand sanitation stations throughout the tournament site.
- Need signs posted around tournament site encouraging:
 - Social Distancing – Stay 6' from others
 - Sanitizing & Washing Hands
 - FACE MASK REQUIRED IN THIS AREA
 - Temperature will be checked
 - If you are sick- STAY HOME!
- Limited number of bags handed out.
- One angler per tank. No more than 11 anglers (6' apart) in line. Tanks will be placed 6' apart.
- No other participants or spectators will be allowed in weigh-in area.
- Weigh in process will not be stopped to take photos other than the angler leading the tournament. (If you want a photo of your fish, please take photo in boat prior to weigh in)
- Use two microphones, one on stand for contestants.
- Bags sanitized before going back into the mix.
- If an hourly tournament, only top 5 of the 15 anglers each hour will only be held under the tent.

- The top 5 will have their boats checked and random boat checks will be conducted throughout each of the tournament hours.
- No formal awards ceremony. Award ceremony will be Live streamed on Facebook.
- All drawings, if any, will be conducted during the LIVE streaming. Winners will be notified with arrangement to receive their prize(s).
- Checks will be mailed.
- If you begin to experience symptoms of COVID-19 (fever, cough, and shortness of breath), we ask that you leave and immediately seek medical attention.
