In accordance with Executive Proclamation JBE 2020-52, issued by Governor John Bel Edwards on April 30, 2020, the Resilient Louisiana Commission (“RLC”) is providing for attendance at essential commission and task force meetings via teleconference or video conference as allowed during the pendency of the COVID-19 health emergency.
