## **CERTIFICATION OF INABILITY TO OPERATE DUE TO LACK OF QUORUM**

In accordance with Executive Proclamation JBE 2020-52, issued by Governor John Bel Edwards on April 30, 2020, the Resilient Louisiana Commission ("RLC") is providing for attendance at essential commission and task force meetings via teleconference or video conference as allowed during the pendency of the COVID-19 health emergency. Pursuant to Section 4 of JBE 2020-52, the Restaurants and Entertainment Task Force will provide attendance for the 2:00PM meeting on Wednesday, May 13 via Zoom and in a manner that allows for observation and input by members of the public, as set forth in the Notice posted on May 12. The Restaurants and Entertainment Task Force is unable to operate in person in order to establish quorum as doing so may result in violating Governor Edwards' order that all public gatherings of 10 or more people be suspended or postponed.
