APPEAL

Sommer Brothers Enterprises (Contract #20141045): LED received a request from Sommer Brothers Enterprises appealing the decision to deny their request for late renewal of tax exemption contract by the Board of Commerce and Industry at the February 24, 2021 meeting due to no company representative being present.

However, upon investigation post-meeting, LED discovered that the settings in place for the mechanism established for accepting written comments blocked external emails from reaching LED staff and Sommer Bros. did timely submit a letter for written comment explaining the late renewal and why they would not have a representative present at the meeting.

Furthermore, when the Renewal Application was received on 10/26/20 the company provided a statement from the Lafayette Parish Assessor's Office verifying taxes had <u>not</u> been paid on the assets associated with this contract since expiration. However, upon notification of the denial of the late renewal request in February 2021, Sommer Bros. stated that taxes had been paid on assets prior to 1/1/21.

This item was deferred by the Board at the April 28, 2021 meeting to give the company time to reach an agreement concerning the taxes paid.

§517. Assessed Property

A. The board shall not consider for tax exemption any manufacturing establishment or addition thereto once such establishment or addition has been in operation for a period of six months, unless the assessor of the parish in which the establishment or addition is located certifies in writing that said establishment or addition is not on the taxable rolls. If the establishment or addition is on the taxable rolls the board shall consider granting tax exemption only if the assessor agrees in writing to remove the establishment or addition from the taxable rolls should the tax exemption be granted.

B. The board shall not consider for tax exemption any property listed on an application on which ad valorem property taxes have been paid.
